

Supplementary Material S1 - Interview Questioning Guide

- 1. What was your experience/what signs did you notice that indicated SBV cases in: lambs, ewes, and rams?
- 2. Looking back were there any signs in the affected flock from tupping to lambing that may have indicated there was an issue with SBV infection?
- 3. What signs did you see specifically in ewes that had affected lambs (from tupping to lambing)?
- 4. What sort of lambing assistance did ewes/lambs suspected with SBV need?
- 5. What impact does SBV have on flock welfare?
- 6. What is the expected/estimated financial impact of SBV on the farm (describe where losses occurred)?
- 7. What was the impact on your health and emotional wellbeing?
- 8. Has Schmallenberg meant that you are less likely to farm sheep in the future? If yes, what are the concerns?
- 9. What changes have you made following the experience of SBV in your flock?
- 10. Have you changed the timing of your lambing period? If not, why not?
- 11. With hindsight, when do you suspect SBV infection first occurred in your flock? Do you suspect SBV occurred during autumn/winter 2011 or spring 2012?
- 12. Have you considered using SBV vaccination?

 If yes, would you vaccinate all your sheep?

 If no, would you vaccinate part of the flock e.g., rams, ram lambs, ewe lambs, 2-tooths, ewes?
- 13. If you were warning other producers to be alert to SBV, what typical signs would you expect to see in an outbreak of SBV?
- 14. Do you have any other comments about the impact of Schmallenberg on your flock?
